WISCONSIN GUIDELINES FOR MEMBER OF THE YEAR AWARD

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARD

- 1. Any member of our Association may be nominated as a candidate for the Outstanding Member of the Year Award.
- 2. State Association Officers should not be arbitrarily selected for the Award, nor should they be prohibited from consideration. Officers have been chosen to lead and serve, but is frequently demonstrated that their services go far beyond the routine duties of the office and, thus may be worthy of selection.
- 3. Consideration shall be given for service rendered in the immediately proceeding 12 month period. Such policy will encourage each carrier, even the newest one, to work to achieve the award during the current year.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- 1. The service rendered by the candidate to the rural Letter Carriers' Association.
- 2. Attendance and participation in local, state and national meetings.
- 3. Willingness to accept responsibilities and dedication in performing these duties.
- 4. Fraternal attitude toward others of the Rural Letter Carrier craft.

NOMINATION OF A CANDIDATE

- 1. One letter on community activities may be submitted with a maximum of 2 pages in length.
- 2. The letter of recommendation must be signed.
- 3. Nomination letter should be submitted with a brief resume of the members' accomplishments.
- 4. All information must be in the state secretary's office by June 1st.

COMMITTEE SELECTION FOR MEMBER OF THE YEAR AWARD

- 1. One board member will select five members from different areas of the state.
- 2. Board member will be selected at pre-convention board meeting.
